Thank you for your continued patience with the building work on the Elliott huts.

next week sees the start of the roofing works to the school so we ask you to be considerate of this at drop off and pick-ups.

As part of the development of Sithney school and the reduction of take up of school dinners, from September we will no longer have a cook on site. Our meals will continue to be provided by Chartwells and will be prepared at Porthleven school and served to the children in the hall.

Eventually the current kitchen will become a staff room. The large storage cupboard in the hall will become a servery and the current staff room will become an extra learning area.

Unfortunately, the change in lunch provision will mean that we will have to say goodbye to Rhona at the end of this term. I would like to take this opportunity to thank her for all her hard work in cooking out school lunches over the last few years, she will sadly be missed.

Vandalism

The field/pond etc has been vandalised due to people accessing the field at weekends and evenings. The whole school field- including the bottom left-hand corner where some people (not during school hours) have made camps is private property. It is very upsetting when areas developed by staff, pupils and parents are damaged by unwanted and uninvited visitors.

Summer Reading Challenge


The summer reading challenge begins on Saturday and this is what they could collect whilst doing it.
