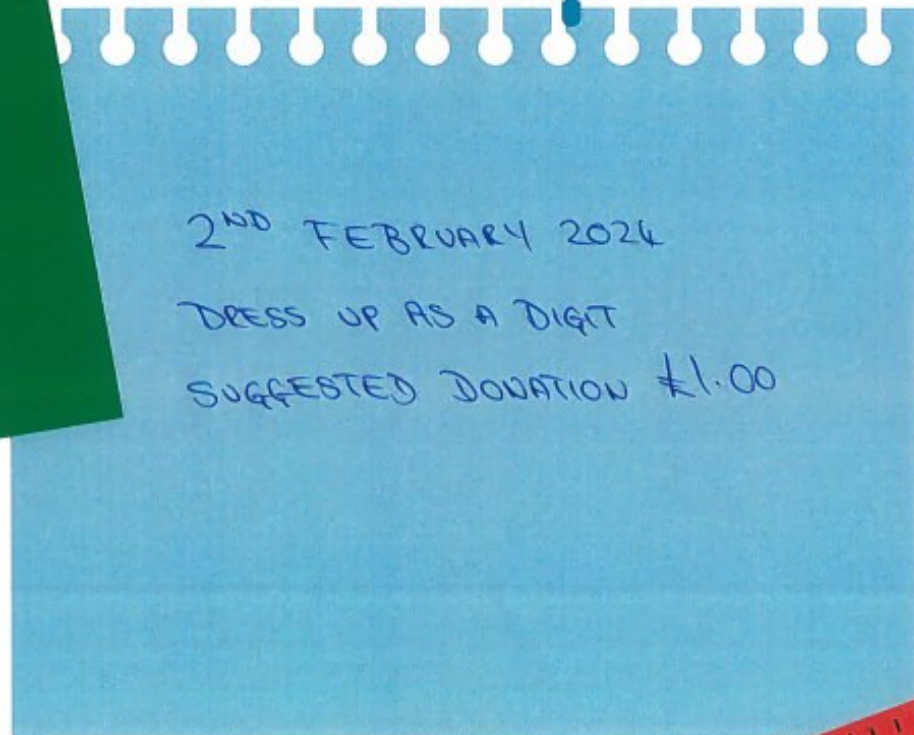
NSPCC Number Day 2024!
