We thank you for your understanding in this matter.

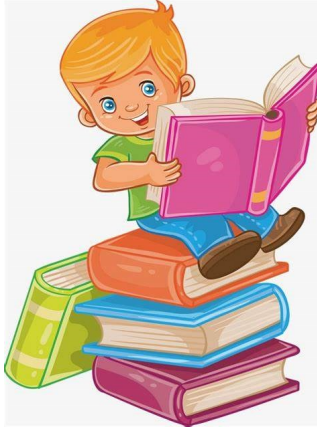
Absences
