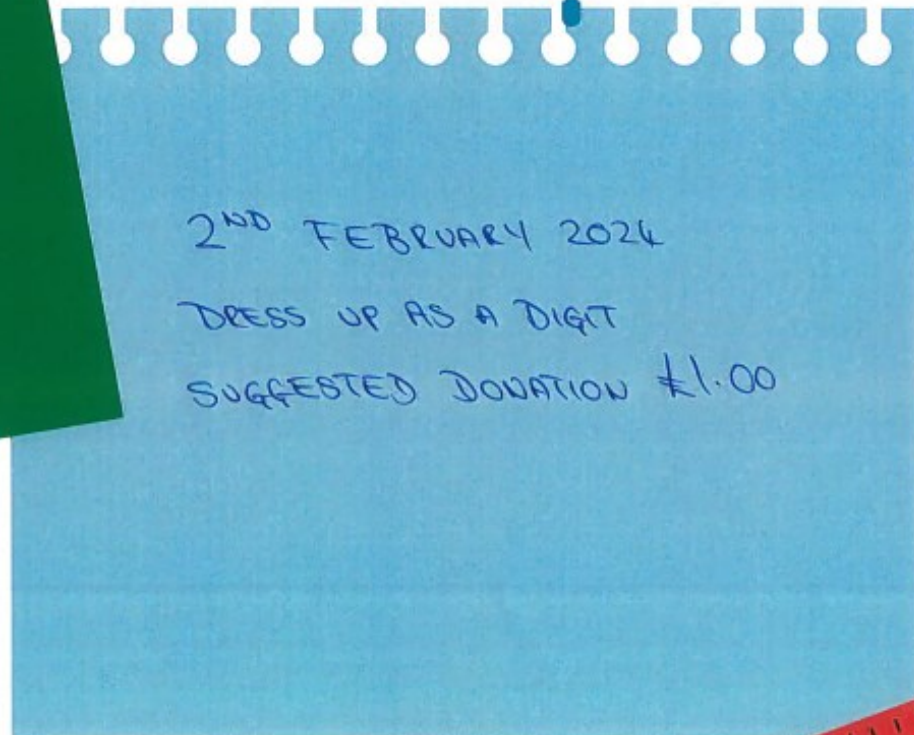
NSPPC Number Day 2024!
