


GENUINE CORNISH PASTY

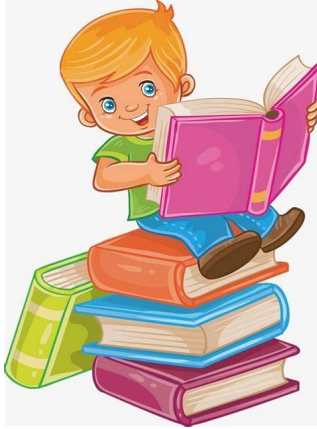
