Ollie said, 'It was interesting and fun; we learnt lots of useful facts.'

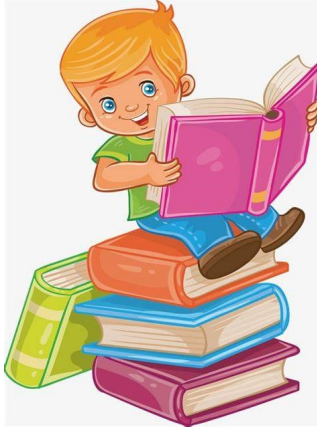
Nico said, 'I liked the sketching. It was great that we had a choice over what to use.'

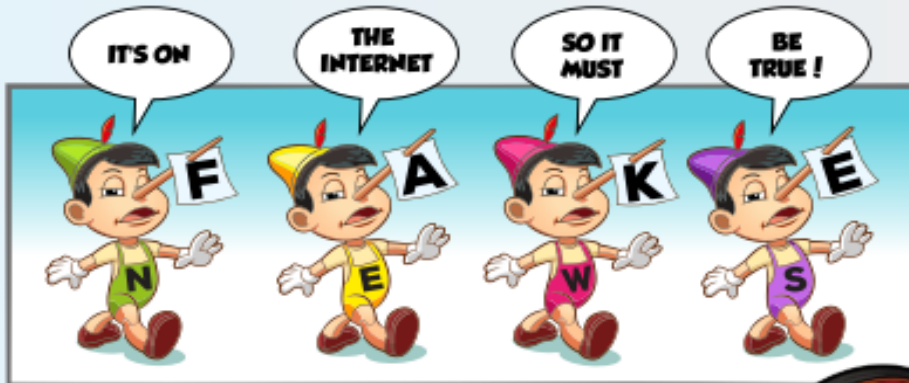
