This means in immediate danger




Key Stage 2 Sibylline

Registering your school



Developmental Language Disorder (DLD)

DLD affects, on average, 2 children in every class of 30. Children with DLD have difficulty understanding what people say to them, and struggle to articulate their ideas and feelings. DLD is 7 times more common than Autism, but hardly anyone has heard of it.
